Statement of Complaint:

In August of 2019, Sergeant Winters discovered a conversation between Captain Kurylowicz and an unidentified person during a forensic search of Captain David Kurylowicz' desktop computer that he used while he was assigned as commander of the Moreno Valley Station. The conversation was sexual in nature, appeared to be a proposition for sex, and occurred during normal working hours. As a result of this, an administrative investigation was initiated.

Summary of Finding:

In August of 2019, Sergeant Shawn Winters was conducting a forensic search of Captain David Kurylowicz' desktop computer that he used while he was assigned as commander of the Moreno Valley Station. This search was being conducted as part of an unrelated personnel investigation. During this search, Sergeant Winters discovered a conversation between [REDACTED]@gmail.com (later determined, by a preponderance of the evidence, to be an email address for Captain David Kurylowicz) and an unidentified person using the email address [REDACTED]@yahoo.com. The conversation was sexual in nature, appeared to be a proposition for sex, and occurred during normal working hours.

The allegation Captain Kurylowicz solicited sex while on-duty, thereby engaging in conduct unbecoming a Sheriff's Captain was sustained. The allegation that Captain Kurylowicz' conduct brought discredit on the department was sustained.

On September 4, 2019, David Kurylowicz resigned from the Riverside County Sheriff's Department.

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

SYNOPSIS:

In August of 2019, Sergeant Shawn Winters was conducting a forensic search of Captain David Kurylowicz' desktop computer that he used while he was assigned as commander of the Moreno Valley Station. This search was being conducted as part of an unrelated personnel investigation. During this search, Sergeant Winters discovered a conversation between [REDACTED]@gmail.com (later determined, by a preponderance of the evidence, to be an email address for Captain David Kurylowicz) and an unidentified person using the email address [REDACTED]@yahoo.com. The conversation was sexual in nature, appeared to be a proposition for sex, and occurred during normal working hours.

The allegation Captain Kurylowicz solicited sex while on-duty, thereby engaging in conduct unbecoming a Sheriff's Captain was sustained. The allegation that Captain Kurylowicz' conduct brought discredit on the department was sustained.

DETAILS:

On August 22, 2019, Lieutenant Kenneth Paulson assigned me to conduct a personnel investigation into allegations of misconduct by Captain Kurylowicz. I obtained and reviewed the Forensic Examination Report obtained from Sergeant Winters. I interviewed Sergeant Winters, as well as Office Assistant Mary Watts, who was Captain Kurylowicz' assistant during the time the misconduct took place.

Shortly after I was assigned this investigation by Lieutenant Paulson, Captain Kurylowicz resigned his position as Sheriff's Captain and declined to participate in an interview regarding the allegations of misconduct being investigated.

SUMMARY OF FORENSIC EXAMINATION REPORT:

The Forensic Examination Report contains a snapshot of a conversation between [REDACTED]@gmail.com and [REDACTED]yahoo.com.

The conversation begins on July 6, 2018 at 0459 hours:

[REDACTED]@gmail.com: ?????

[REDACTED]yahoo.com: *Yeah Riverside send a pic so we can meet.*

There then appears to be a large gap in time and the conversation resumes on July 10, 2018, at 1336 hours:

[REDACTED]@gmail.com: *Can you text?*

[REDACTED]yahoo.com: *No I can not bro u can't tall (call) here*

[REDACTED]@gmail.com: *ok are you gay? bi? Straight? Or just horny?*

[REDACTED]yahoo.com: *horny/curious*

[REDACTED]@gmail.com: *Where in riverside are you? I live in [REDACTED]*

[REDACTED]yahoo.com: *By Moreno Valley*

[REDACTED]@gmail.com: *I work in Moval What area? Do you have a place?*

[REDACTED]yahoo.com: *By Mission Grove no I don't*

This is the last conversation documented in the Forensic Exam Report. The last reply by [REDACTED]yahoo.com occurred at 1404 hours. The time stamp for the last sentence sent by [REDACTED]@gmail.com was cut-off, but occurred sometime after [REDACTED]yahoo.com's next to last reply at 1350 hours, and before his last reply at 1404 hours.

ADMINISTRATIVE INTERVIEW WITH SERGEANT SHAWN WINTERS:

On September 11, 2019, at 1315 hours, Sergeant Wade Lenton and I conducted a digitally-recorded interview with Sergeant Shawn Winters at the Special Investigations Bureau. I explained to Sergeant Winters he was not the focus of the investigation and the purpose of this interview was to obtain additional information regarding allegations that Captain Kurylowicz solicited sex while on-duty. I ordered Sergeant Winters to answer our questions accurately, completely, and truthfully. Sergeant Winters said he understood the order and agreed to answer our questions. The following is a summary of his statement.

Sergeant Winters began his career with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department [REDACTED] and is currently assigned to Computer and Technology Crime and Hi-Tech Response Team (CATCH).

[REDACTED]

Sergeant Winters has received several hundred hours of training in the area of computer forensics. Sergeant Winters has taken several classes from the California Department of Justice, involving computer forensics. Sergeant Winters has received several hundreds of hours of training from several private companies that design and produce software tools that assist in the forensic examination of computers. Sergeant Winters is a court recognized expert in the field of computer forensics. While assigned to CATCH, Sergeant Winters has conducted numerous forensic examinations on computers. Sergeant Winters used the Magnet Forensics Axion program to examine Captain Kurylowicz' work computer.

Sergeant Winters had been asked to examine Captain Kurylowicz' computers, as part of a separate administrative investigation. In January or February of 2019, Sergeant Winters obtained the two computers from Lieutenant Lelevier at the Moreno Valley Station and brought them to his office at CATCH². His first step was to make a forensic image of the computers' memory. This creates an exact copy of the memory and is what Sergeant Winters used to conduct his examination, so as to not risk damaging or altering the original evidence. In May or June of 2019, Sergeant Winters completed the examination of the computers.

Several weeks later, Sergeant Winters was contacted by Lieutenant Paulson from the Professional Standards Bureau. Lieutenant Paulson asked Sergeant Winters to take another look at the information he gleaned from Captain Kurylowicz' computer and see if there was any evidence that he was doing any work as a college professor on County equipment or while he was on-duty. During this search, Sergeant Winters discovered the message string discussed above that is the focus of this administrative investigation. Sergeant Winters could not recall the exact date that he located these messages, but he said it was mid-August 2019.

Sergeant Winters said that the messages were not located on the computers' hard drive in a manner as one would typically find, but rather in what is called a hiberfil.sys file. He went on to explain that a hiberfile.sys is created when the computer goes into the sleep or hibernation mode and the operating

1 system writes the information on the screen to the hard drive in a hiberfil.sys file, so that whenever the
2 user logs back on, and the computer comes out of hibernation mode, the information previous displayed
3 before the computer went into the hibernation state is immediately displayed for the user. Due to the
4 nature of this file, Sergeant Winters said the file he located only contains a snippet of information and
5 may not contain the complete conversation.

6
7 Sergeant Winters believed that the time stamps, that are attached to each message, are accurate and are
8 in pacific time. These times are reflective of the time the messages were created and not the time the
9 message was written to the computer. Sergeant Winters determined the conversation was between two
10 individuals; [REDACTED]@gmail.com and [REDACTED]@yahoo.com.³ The conversation on
11 July 10, 2018 started at 1336 hours, and ended with the last message from
12 [REDACTED]@yahoo.com at 1404 hours.

13
14 Upon reviewing the message string, and the totality of the forensic exam, Sergeant Winters concluded
15 the message were created on a dating type application called "double list" and he located an associated
16 advertisement number. Sergeant Winters located the doublelist.com website and created a fictitious
17 account in order to attempt to locate an ad for either [REDACTED]@gmail.com or
18 [REDACTED]@yahoo.com. Sergeant Winters characterized doublelist.com as a dating website
19 organized similar to craigslist with many advertisements and the nature of the advertisements were
20 more geared toward casual sexual encounters, rather than those looking for long term relationships.
21 The website did not have a search function and Sergeant Winters was unable to locate the
22 advertisements or profile for [REDACTED]@gmail.com or [REDACTED]@yahoo.com.

23
24 Based on the totality of the activity he located during the forensic examination, Sergeant Winters
25 formed the opinion that Captain Kurylowicz was the only person using that computer around the time
26 the messages were created. Sergeant Winters based this opinion on several factors. At 1038 hours, on
27 the day the messages were created, the user (Dkurylow) logged on to the computer with his credentials.
28 No other users were logged on before, during, or after the time the messages were created.

29
30 Between the time the user (Dkurylow) logged on and the last message being sent by
31 [REDACTED]@yahoo.com, there were several emails sent and received from Captain
32 Kurylowicz' department email. There were several official files accessed just prior and during the time
33 the messages were created. Sergeant Winters located evidence that a commanders' meeting was
34 scheduled at 1400 hours on that day. The user (Dkurylow) accessed a vacation file, meeting agenda
35 document, and a PERS tracking sheet for Moreno Valley Station. This is consistent with the station
36 commander, Captain Kurylowicz, preparing for the station commanders' meeting. The meeting time of
37 1400 hours is also consistent with the time the messages between [REDACTED]@gmail.com and
38 [REDACTED]@yahoo.com stopped.⁴

39
40 I ordered Sergeant Winters not to discuss any aspects of the investigation or the interview with anyone
41 other than a legal representative. Sergeant Winters agreed to comply with the order and the interview
42 concluded.

ADMINISTRATIVE INTERVIEW WITH [REDACTED]@YAHOO.COM:

On August 22, 2019, I sent an email to [REDACTED]@yahoo.com, explaining to him that he had been identified as a witness in a non-criminal, administrative investigation regarding possible misconduct of one of our employees. I provide my desk telephone number, cellular telephone number and email address, and asked that he contact me if he was willing to participate in the investigation. I was never contacted by anyone identifying themselves as the owner of the [REDACTED]@yahoo.com email address.

ADMINISTRATIVE INTERVIEW WITH OFFICE ASSISTANT MARY WATTS:

On September 12, 2019, at 1540 hours, Sergeant Wade Lenton and I conducted a digitally-recorded interview with Office Assistant Mary Watts at the Moreno Valley Station. I explained to Office Assistant Watts she was not the focus of the investigation and the purpose of this interview was to obtain additional information regarding allegations Captain Kurylowicz was engaged in misconduct on July 10, 2018. I ordered Office Assistant Watts to answer our questions accurately, completely, and truthfully. Office Assistant Watts said she understood the order and agreed to answer our questions.

1 The following is a summary of her statement.

2
3 Office Assistant Watts has been assigned to the Moreno Valley Station as an Office Assistant since
4 [REDACTED] Office Assistant Watts is currently a lead OA III in the Business/Records Unit and serves
5 as the Administrative Assistant to the current station commander, Lieutenant David Lelevier. Prior to
6 acting as the Administrative Assistant to Lieutenant Lelevier, Office Assistant Watts was similarly
7 assigned as the Office Assistant to Captain Kurylowicz and was so assigned on July 10, 2018.

8
9 As the Administrative Assistant, Office Assistant Watts' workstation is located just outside of the
10 station commander's office. Anyone going in or out of the commander's office has to walk past Office
11 Assistant Watts' desk. Anyone going into the commander's office is required to check-in with Office
12 Assistant Watts first.

13
14 Although Office Assistant Watts does not have an independent recollection of July 10, 2018, she was
15 in possession of a copy of Captain Kurylowicz' calendar and what was scheduled for that day. Office
16 Assistant Watts provided a copy of the calendar to me. For July 10, 2018, the only item on Captain
17 Kurylowicz' calendar was a staff meeting at 1400 hours, in the Captain's conference room. Office
18 Assistant Watts said that she took notes of that meeting and those notes would document who was in
19 attendance.

20
21 Office Assistant Watts was not in possession of those notes at the time of the interview, but said she
22 would provide them as soon as possible.⁶

23
24 Office Assistant Watts said it is not common practice for others to enter the Captain's Office and use
25 his computer and, she does not remember that ever occurring. She said Captain Kurylowicz never
26 shared his computer user name and password with her or anyone else, that she knows of, nor did Captain
27 Kurylowicz ever mention doing so.

28
29 Office Assistant Watts does not recall ever seeing anything related to [REDACTED]@gmail.com
30 or [REDACTED]@yahoo.com while acting as the Administrative Assistant for Captain
31 Kurylowicz.

32
33 I ordered Office Assistant Watts not to discuss any aspects of the investigation or the interview with
34 anyone other than a legal representative. Office Assistant Watts agreed to comply with the order and
35 the interview concluded.

36
37 **ADMINISTRATIVE INTERVIEW WITH CAPTAIN DAVID KURYLOWICZ:**

38
39 On August 22, 2019, I contacted Captain Kurylowicz by telephone and by email, and informed him he
40 was the focus of an administrative investigation involving solicitation of sex on duty⁷. I scheduled an

administrative interview with Captain Kurylowicz for September 17, 2019, at 1100 hours. Subsequently, the Department's legal counsel, [REDACTED] notified Captain Kurylowicz' legal counsel, [REDACTED] that Captain Kurylowicz should be prepared to discuss his association with the screenname [REDACTED]. On September 4, 2019, Captain Kurylowicz resigned from his position with the Riverside Sheriff's Department and declined to participate in the administrative interview⁸.

CONCLUSIONS:

ALLEGATION THAT CAPTAIN KURYLOWICZ' CONDUCT WAS UNBECOMING A SHERIFF'S CAPTAIN:

This investigation determined there is preponderant evidence that Captain Kurylowicz engaged in conduct that was unbecoming a Sheriff's Captain when he solicited sex while on-duty. In his administrative interview, Sergeant Winters told me that he concluded Captain Kurylowicz was the only user logged on to the computer the day the messages were exchanged. He based that opinion, in part, on the fact that there were several emails both sent and received from Captain Kurylowicz' department email account. Around the same time the messages were sent, there were also several documents accessed that would be consistent with Captain Kurylowicz preparing for a meeting that Sergeant Winters found evidence was occurring that day and was later corroborated by Office Assistant Mary Watts. Based on that evidence, coupled with the statements from Mary Watts that she could not recall a time when anyone other than Captain Kurylowicz used his computer, I concluded that Captain Kurylowicz was the author and intended recipient of the messages located by Sergeant Winters.

More specifically, based on the content of the messages there is a preponderance of evidence that [REDACTED]@gmail.com is a pseudonym for Captain Kurylowicz. Additionally, [REDACTED]@gmail.com wrote that he works in Moreno Valley, which Captain Kurylowicz did at the time. Captain Kurylowicz is also a college professor (adjunct) at the University of San Diego, as listed on the University of San Diego website with his picture and biography⁹.

The overall tenor of the conversation was Captain Kurylowicz orchestrating a sexual meeting with [REDACTED]@yahoo.com. Captain Kurylowicz asked about the other person's sexual orientation and, after [REDACTED]@yahoo.com replied that he was horny/curious, Captain Kurylowicz immediately inquired whether [REDACTED]@yahoo.com has a place where they can meet. This combined with Sergeant Winters' opinion that the website they were communicating through was orientated for those looking for casual sexual encounters shows that Captain Kurylowicz' purpose for communicating with [REDACTED]@yahoo.com was to arrange a sexual meeting with him. This all was communicated while Captain Kurylowicz was on-duty and using a Department computer.

The Department requires all members to subscribe to a Value Statement as defined in the General Orders. The Department expects all members to have integrity, loyalty, professionalism, and leadership. The Department has adopted the Value Statement into its General Orders and thereby the code has become Department policy, which includes the phrases:

We are dedicated to honesty and integrity in all our actions and will uphold our ethical beliefs regardless of the consequences. Our actions must be above reproach.

We will serve with honor and vitality. Our professionalism dictates critical self-appraisal and objective analysis, with a commitment to community betterment. We will maintain the position of honor entrusted to us by those we serve.

The Department requires all members to subscribe to a Code of Ethics as defined in the General Orders. The Department has adopted the Code of Ethics into its General Orders and thereby the Code has become Department policy, which includes the phrases:

...I will keep my private life unsullied as an example to all; maintain courageous calm in the face of danger, scorn, or ridicule; develop self-restraint; and be constantly mindful of the welfare of others. I will be exemplary in obeying the laws of the land and the regulations of my department...

Captain Kurylowicz' failure to adhere to the ethics provisions of the code by his conduct constitutes a further act of misconduct and violation of General Orders by his failure to obey the regulations of the Department. The totality and severity of these sustained allegations further showed his actions were not in any way conduct or behavior condoned by the Department. Therefore, the allegation that Captain Kurylowicz' actions were conduct unbecoming a Sheriff's Captain when he solicited sex while on-duty is **sustained** and a violation of the following general orders:

GENERAL ORDERS SECTION 102.01

The Department requires all members to subscribe to an ethical standard of conduct as defined in the Law Enforcement Code of Ethics. The Department expects all members to act in a reasonable, considerate and professional manner to fellow members and the public at all times.

GENERAL ORDERS 202.04:

Department members, whether on or off duty, shall be governed by ordinary and reasonable rules of good conduct and behavior.

GENERAL ORDERS 202.18:

Department employees shall devote their full time and attention to the services of the Department while on duty.

GENERAL ORDERS 1200.3:

Department members are under a duty to act solely for the benefit of the Sheriff's Department in all matters connected with their employment. Personal use of any computer system, network, terminal, peripheral, etc., not connected to the employee's official duties is prohibited.

ALLEGATION THAT CAPTAIN KURYLOWICZ' CONDUCT BROUGHT DISCREDIT ON THE DEPARTMENT:

The on-duty actions of Captain Kurylowicz have the potential, and will likely become public record, which would bring discredit to the Department when the on-duty misconduct of a high-ranking Department member is disclosed by law. Additionally, Office Assistant Watts and Sergeant Winters are now aware of the misconduct Captain Kurylowicz engaged in while on-duty. Therefore, the

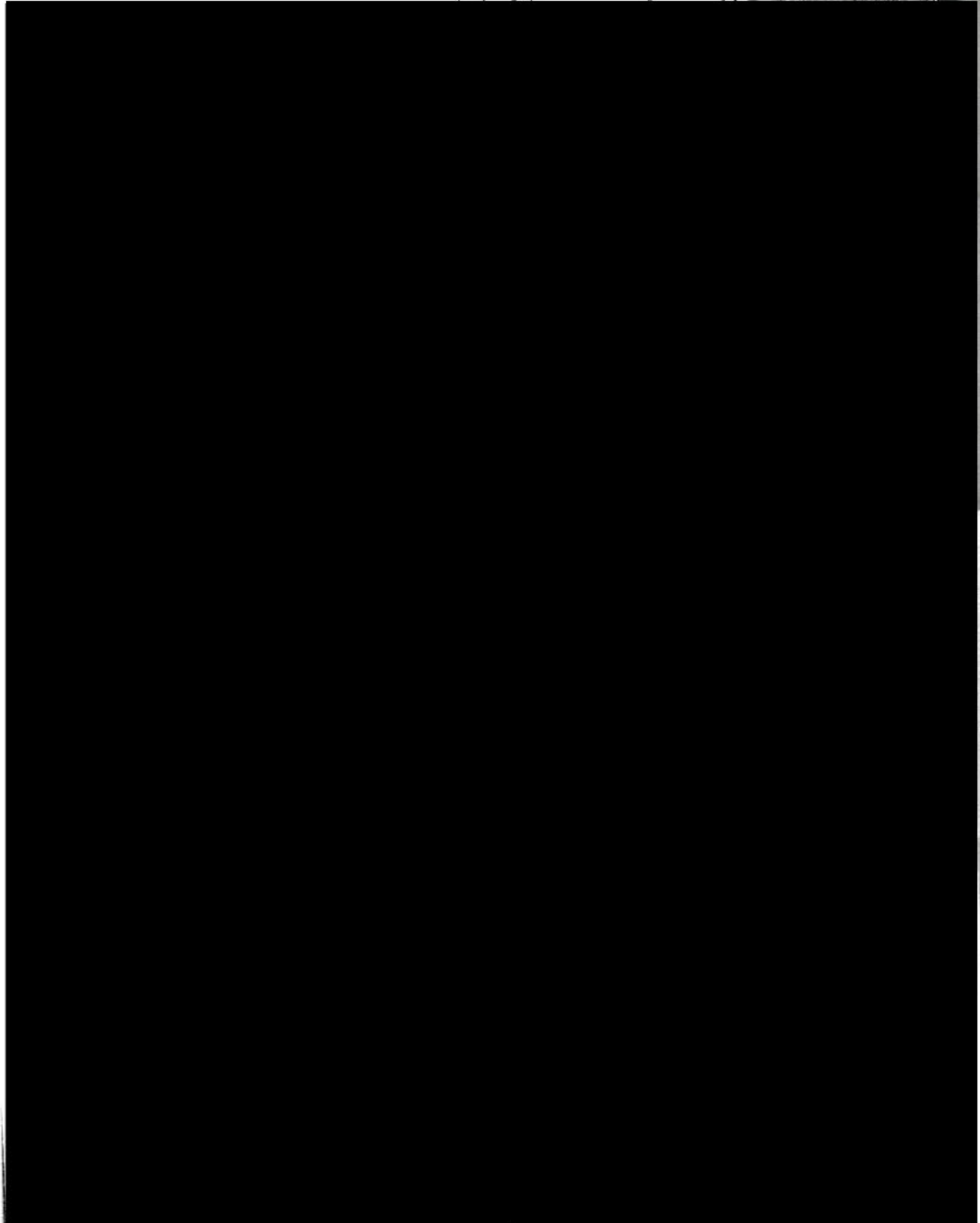

Request:

On August 8, 2019, I was contacted by Lieutenant Ken Paulson of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department – Professional Standards Bureau. Lieutenant Paulson requested I conduct an additional examination of Captain David Kurylowicz's department owned computers, which I previously examined during personnel investigation [REDACTED] new allegations are being investigated under personnel investigation #PERS2019-0111). Lieutenant Paulson requested I search the computer for possible information related to Kurylowicz having outside employment at a college and/or evidence that Kurylowicz was conducting college course activities while on duty for the Sheriff's Department.

Summary:

The computer was forensically examined per Lieutenant Paulson's request. The results of the examination are summarized as follows:

1. I located documents related to David Kurylowicz's employment at the University of San Diego.
2. I did not locate evidence that lead me to believe Captain Kurylowicz was instructing or conducting University of San Diego business while on duty for the Sheriff's Department.
3. I located additional evidence of potential misconduct, Gmail Chat snippet thread, which I reported to Lieutenant Paulson.

Background:

I am employed as a Sergeant for the Riverside Sheriff's Department assigned to C.A.T.C.H. (Computer and Technology Crime High Tech Response Team). I am a certified computer forensics examiner with C.A.T.C.H. and I have received specialized training in computer forensics from various government and private entities.

Previously each examined item was individually cataloged and photographed under PERS investigation [REDACTED]. As part of the cataloging procedures, each examined item was assigned a unique C.A.T.C.H. *Bar Code Number (BCN)*. The BCN may have been assigned for evidence control upon initial submission to C.A.T.C.H., depending on how the item was packaged. The items are identified in this narrative by their respective BCN.

For each *original* media item or data storage device (Original Digital Evidence or *ODE*) examined, a duplicate *physical image*¹ was created and saved to forensically prepared media. This media is also referred to as *Duplicate Digital Evidence (DDE)*. The DDE was created

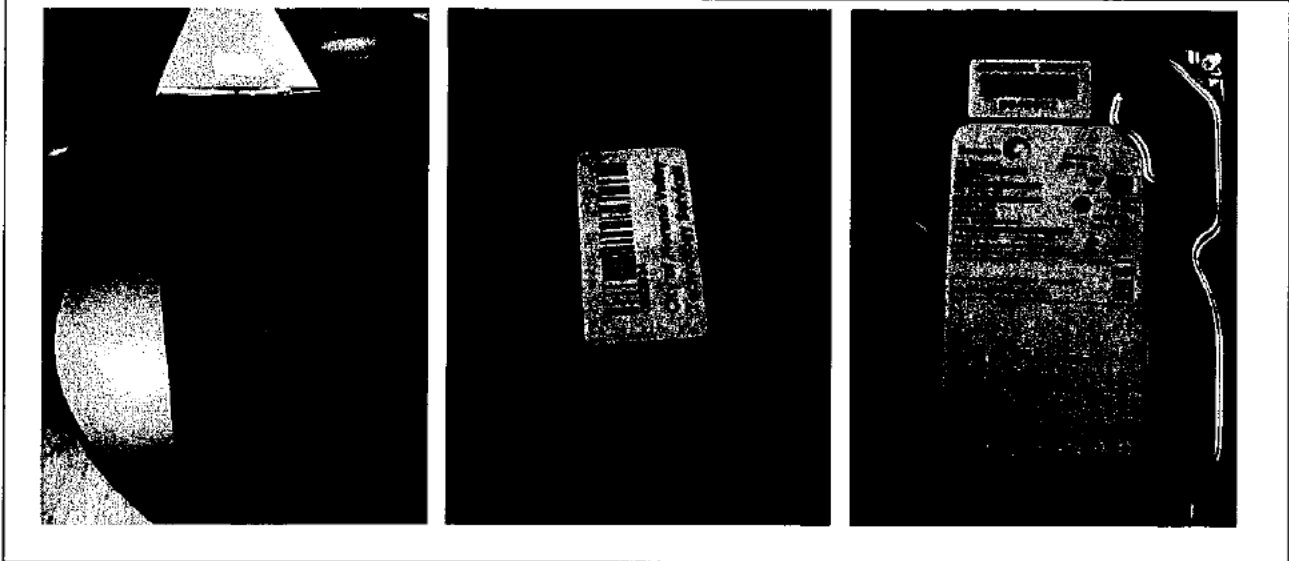

INSTRUCTOR EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

This Instructor Employment Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between David Karylowicz, MBA (Instructor) and the University of San Diego ("USD"), a California non-profit public benefit corporation.

WHEREAS, USD offers various programs through its Division of Professional and Continuing Education;

WHEREAS, Instructor has the skills necessary to provide instructional services to USD in connection with programs offered through USD's Division of Professional and Continuing Education, and USD wishes to employ Instructor for that purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, and the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. Scope of Work. USD hereby retains Instructor to perform the instructional services set forth in Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference. Instructor represents that Instructor has the background, training and experience to perform properly the services to be delivered under this Agreement.

2. Condition of Employment. A background investigation is required as a condition of your employment with USD. Your employment with USD and USD's obligations under this Agreement are conditioned on USD's approval of your employment following its acceptance of the results of the background investigation.

3. Employment.
a. You shall be a temporary employee of USD. This is a non-exclusive basis position, and you are not eligible to receive any benefits offered by USD to employees in benefit-based positions.

b. We have every hope that your employment with the University will be mutually beneficial and rewarding. However, we recognize that personnel changes may be initiated by either you or the University. Your employment with the University is at will and is not for a fixed period of time. Either you or the University may choose to end your employment relationship at any time, with or without notice or cause. No severance, notice, or other compensation or benefits of the University shall be payable to any employee upon termination of the at-will nature of your employment relationship with the University.

c. Expenses incurred by Instructor are not reimbursable unless approved in advance and in writing by the Division of Professional and Continuing Education. To the extent USD

agrees to reimburse Instructor for reasonable business expenses that are necessarily incurred by Instructor in the performance of the services under this Agreement, all expense reimbursement requests are subject to the standards set forth in the University's Expense Reimbursement Procedures.

4. Course and Course Materials. The University will retain copyright ownership of the course and course materials, including the course title, the course description, the course content outline, and the class syllabus. Instructor may use such materials only in connection with performing services under this Agreement, and for no other purpose without the advance written permission of USD.

5. USD Approvals. USD shall be responsible for approving, in advance of the performance of services by Instructor, the following: all instructor-developed course content, course descriptions, course syllabi, and course materials, including but not limited to course outlines, class studies, and instructional support materials such as PowerPoint® slides used in the instructional course and/or program.

6. Qualification and Liability for Property. If Instructor is unable or fails to perform for any reason, USD is granted the right to use Instructor's course materials and may appoint a temporary instructor to complete the course. In that case, Instructor shall receive a pro-rated payment for actual amount of instruction provided.

7. Course Cancellation. USD may cancel the course identified in Exhibit A due to low enrollment, inability to secure an appropriate facility, or for other legitimate business reasons as determined by USD. If the course is cancelled, Instructor understands and agrees that this Agreement shall terminate and no payment from USD to Instructor will be due.

8. Use of USD's Name and Logo. Instructor shall not use the name "USD," "University of San Diego," "Torrey," or use any logo or insignia of or otherwise identify USD, the Torrey or any division or office of USD in any form of publicity, disclosure or sale without the prior written consent of USD, which consent may be withheld, granted or withheld by USD in its sole discretion. Instructor shall not provide to or permit any third party to use any such logo or insignia or identify USD, the Torrey or any division or office of USD without the advance written approval of USD.

12. Assignment of Rights. This Agreement may not be assigned, except through a written signed by authorized representatives of USD and Instructor. If any provision of this Agreement, or part thereof, is held invalid, void or unenforceable

against public policy or otherwise, the provision shall not affect other provisions, or parts thereof, which may be given effect without the invalid provision or part. To this extent, the provision, and parts thereof, of this Agreement are severable.

13. Entire Agreement. The parties declare and represent that no promise, understanding or agreement not herein expressed has been made to them and that this Agreement contains the full and entire agreement between and among the parties relating to the subject matter herein, and that the terms of this Agreement are complete and not subject to any other oral or written agreement.

On August 22, 2019, Sergeant David Clark from the Professional Standards Bureau contacted me and requested additional information reference my findings. Sergeant Clark requested I examine the computer further and attempt to determine the computer user at the time of the Gmail webmail snippets and also requested any additional information I could locate in reference to the Gmail webmail snippet string.

On August 26, 2019, I began an additional examination of the digital evidence. The previous located Gmail webmail text/chat snippets were located in a hiberfil.sys file. A hiberfil.sys file is a Windows computer system created file and is created when the computer goes into hibernation mode. Hibernation mode uses the hiberfil.sys file to save the current state (memory) of the computer onto the hard drive and the file is used when the Windows computer system is turned back on and brings the computer back to the previous state for the user.

As you review the below listed file, you see that the hiberfil.sys file was created on July 10, 2018 at 2:18:57 PM. This when the computer went into a hibernation state; however, when you review the snippet, you see a date and time of July 10, 2018 at 1:45 PM and July 10, 2018 at 1:36 PM. I believe this date and time is when the chat / message was sent.

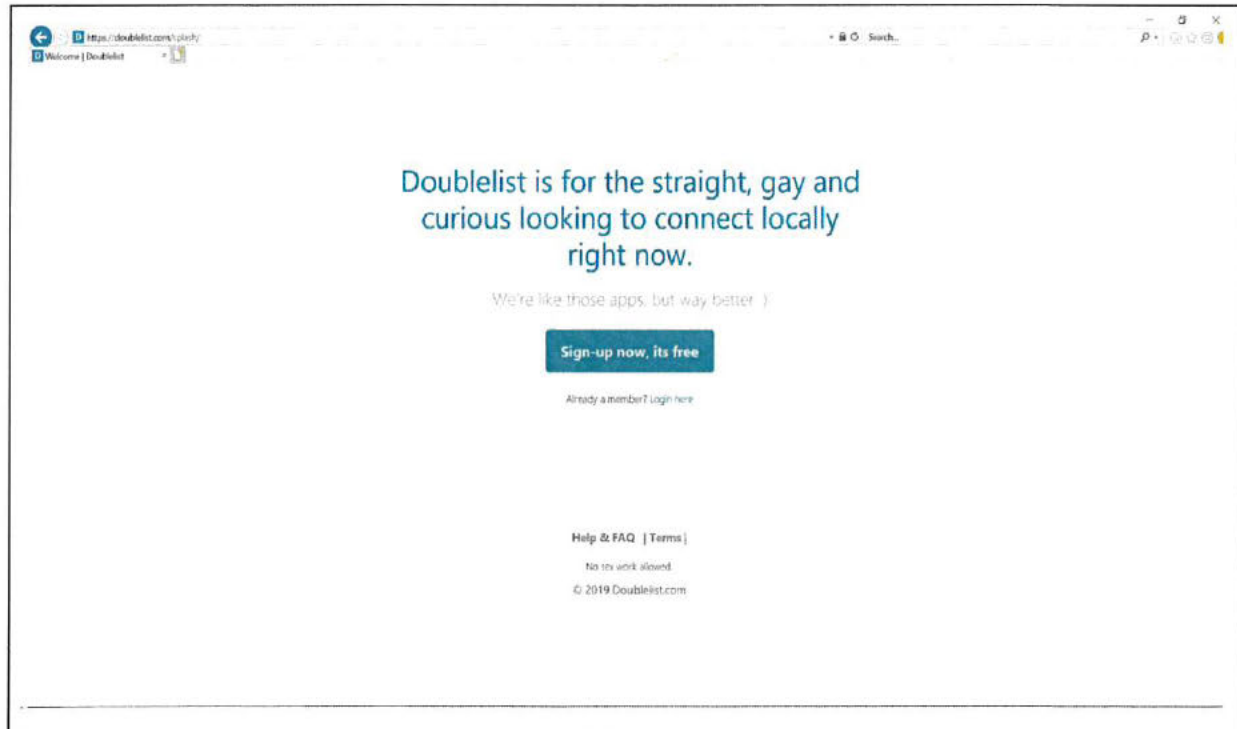

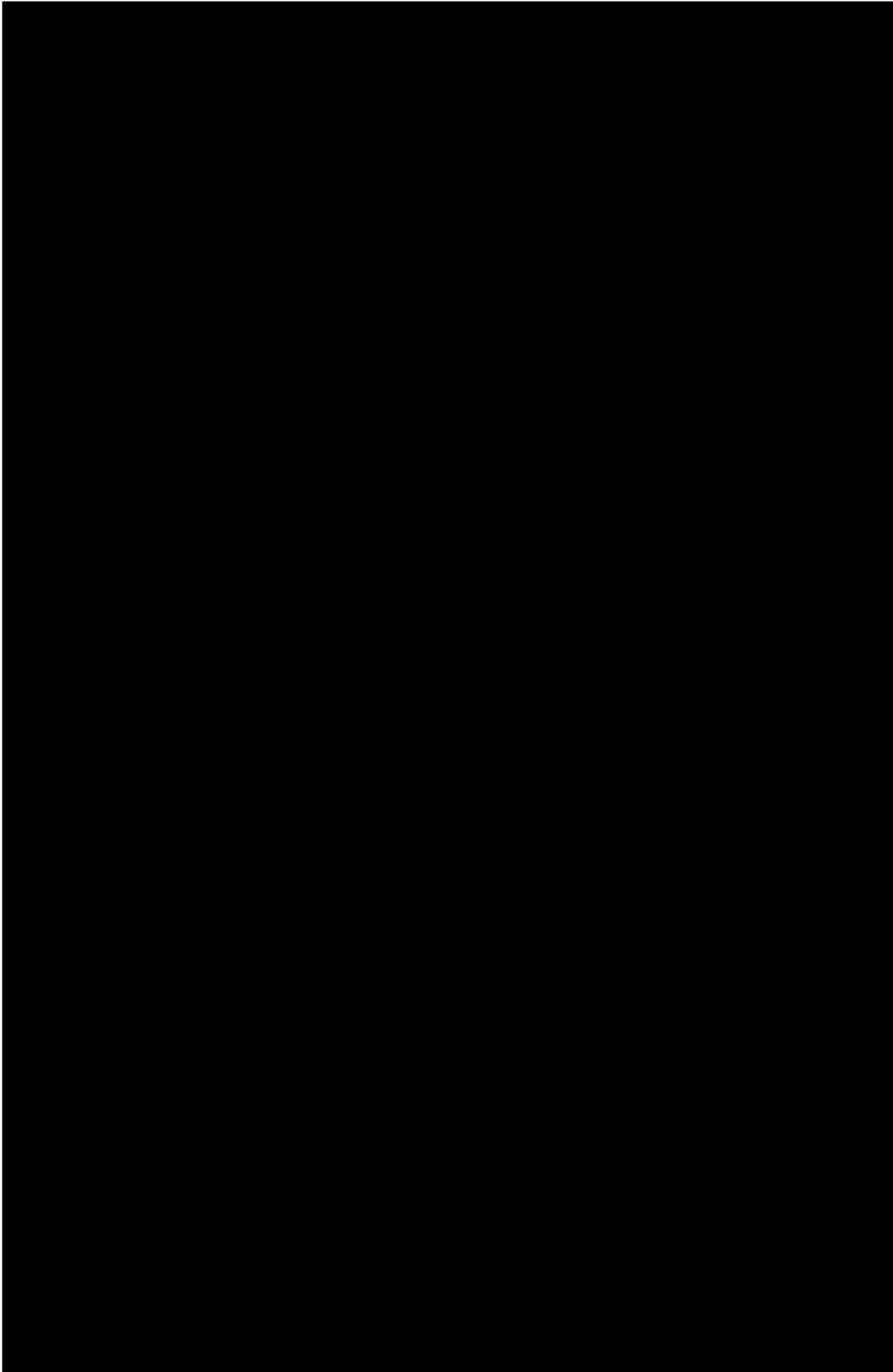

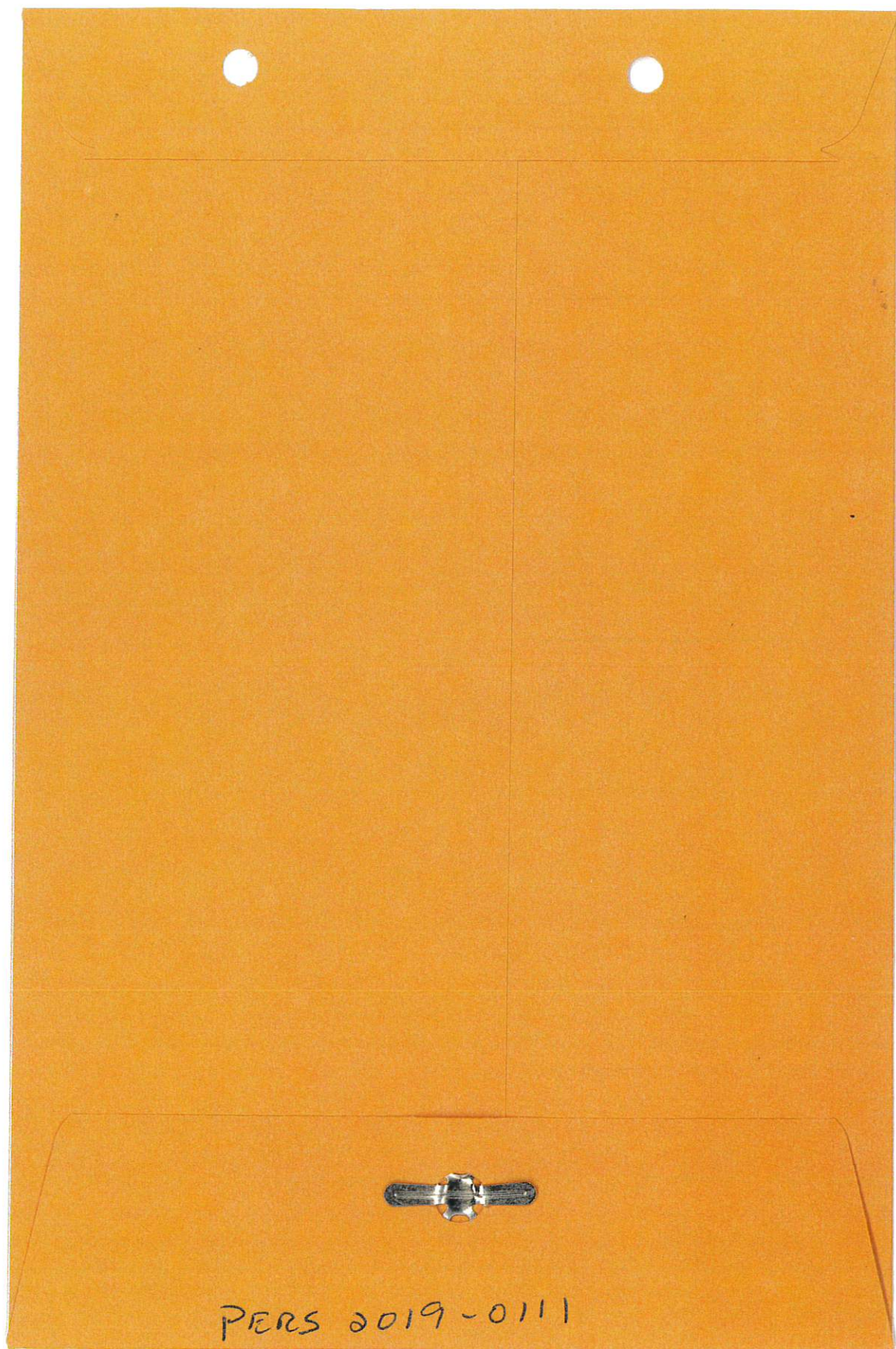
